OUTSTANDING SERVICE Kung is well known as a LASIK eye surgeon, inventor, instructor and consultant. He has saved or enhanced the vision of thousands of patients. He is the inventor of the Kung Guide ophthalmic surgical instrument, which is used as a guide for incisions during surgery to correct nearsightedness.

Kung is a graduate of Mt. Sinai School of Medicine where he earned distinction in research. He served his residency in ophthalmology at Columbia University-Presbyterian Medical Center. He is a consultant to several companies including Novartis, Allergan, Alcon and Pharmacia. Kung is the author of a book on laser vision and has published many articles on eye diseases and surgical techniques. He is a frequent instructor in new techniques for eye surgery. He lectures nationally and internationally on eye diseases and surgical procedures.

BROAD RANGE OF EXPERTISE Kung handles all aspects of eye disease and surgery including cataracts, advanced implants, glaucoma, macular degeneration and the effects of diabetes. He was one of the first doctors to use advanced implants during cataract surgery to correct astigmatism and presbyopia. Most of these patients no longer need glasses to read afterwards. He also pioneered the “express mini shunt,” which is inserted into the eye of a glaucoma sufferer to decrease pressure on the eye.

Kung has a history of honors and awards including being named to Marquis *Who's Who in America* in medicine and healthcare, finance and industry, science and engineering. He has lectured and demonstrated refractive surgery to Chinese ophthalmologists, and other foreign governments have consulted him about various aspects of vision and surgery.

He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology, a member of the American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgery, a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and of the International Society for Refractive Surgery. He is also affiliated with St. Peter's University Hospital and Richmond University Medical Center.
